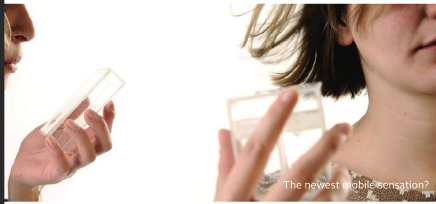

### OPEN SOURCE DESIGNING

While technology has greatly improved global access to telecommunications and music, architectural design has been the last digital frontier. Until now that is. OpenSimSim is a new open source (community-driven platform) design network. It enables users from around the world to interact in the architectural design process with the help of Web 2.0.

**Daniel Dendra**, a Berlin-based architect and co-founder of OpenSimSim which launched at the Venice Biennale in 2010 explains: "We use open source tools such as Wikipedia and OpenOffice every day. Why not use open source to reinvent cities where 98 per cent of the buildings are not designed by architects?"
